<b>Cardiology-grade stethoscope</b> (must have a separate bell & diaphragm)	
<b>Sphygmomanometer</b> adult and small adult size cuffs required (Large adult and pediatric size cuffs are optional)	
<b>Oral thermometer</b> (digital–should give audible signal after 1 minute)	
<b>Disposable thermometer shields</b>	
<b>Watch</b> (digital or analog - must display seconds)	
<b>3.5v otoscope/ophthalmoscope set</b> (with rechargeable handle)	
<b>Disposable otoscope speculums</b>	
<b>Pocket eye chart</b> (Rosenbaum chart)	
<b>Pen light</b>	
<b>Tongue depressors</b> (individually wrapped)	
<b>Tape measure</b> (standard & metric increments)	
<b>Ruler</b> (standard & metric increments) (*Can use eye chart ruler)
