***NOTE: Newer versions of the equipment listed below is acceptable.
Do not purchase equipment older than the versions listed below.***

1. Stethoscope (select any of the following):
 - MDF Cardiology Pro: www.mdfinstruments.com
 - Littman Cardiology III (or newer model) with diaphragm and bell, and with comfortable ear pieces.

NOTE: Although there are many more stethoscopes that are comparable, these are the most cost effective without losing quality.

2. Ophthalmoscope & Otoscope Diagnostic Set (Not allowed to use PanOptic for testing)
3. Disposable Otoscope Speculum - Adult
4. Blood Pressure Cuff (sphygmomanometer)
5. Reflex / percussion hammer
6. Tuning fork set (128 cps and 512 cps)
7. Sharp & dull sensation tester (tongue blades or paperclips are acceptable)
8. Rosenbaum Pocket eye chart (example: <http://www.west-op.com/pocketeyechart.html>)
9. Pen light
10. Individually wrapped tongue depressors
11. Small pocket ruler with centimeter and millimeter measurement capability
12. Cotton balls (for light touch testing)
13. Flexible tape measure with centimeter and millimeter measurement capability
14. Latex-free gloves (buy a box for economy)
15. CEIL blue scrubs (matching top and bottom – 2 sets recommended)
16. PD lab uniform – T-shirt & navy blue shorts with NSU PAO Program logo (2 sets recommended).
Females: sports bra for the cardiac exam.
