Early Decision Facts

Early decision is the opportunity to submit an application to NSU's PDPT program right at the start of the application acceptance period. The advantage to applying through early decision is that the admissions committee will get first look at your application. This allows you to potentially be accepted earlier than other candidates. To be accepted as an early decision applicant, you need to meet slightly higher minimum criteria.

Early decision applications must meet the following criteria:

- Minimum GPA of 3.5 (cumulative, science/math and prerequisites)
- Combined GRE Verbal and Quantitative test score of 305, with a writing score of 4.0
- 100 hours of PT observation
- 3 Letters of recommendation with 1 from a Physical Therapist
- All prerequisites must be completed
- \$1000 non-refundable deposit
- Must have evidence of volunteered community service

Early decision applications are accepted from July through August. Early decision applicants will be notified by October 1.
