

NSU Professional DPT Program – Fort Lauderdale Equipment and Technology Requirements

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

This equipment will be used in anatomy (Year 1) and neuroanatomy (year 2) Labs. Anatomy faculty will be reviewing the use of this equipment. You **MUST** purchase these devices before orientation week.

The NSU Bookstore may carry this equipment, but you may also obtain them online. We have listed websites for these products, but you may find them online through various vendors.

- Nitrile gloves (box of 100) – Must be powder-free
 - They are sized small, medium, large or extra-large
 - Nitrile gloves are available at Cosco, many pharmacies, and even Walmart
- Disposable isolation gowns (pkg of 50)
 - Proadvantage is a manufacturer used by the medical sciences department

Equipment for the DPT Classes

Each DPT student must purchase a kit of supplies that will be used throughout the program and throughout their career. In order to facilitate students obtaining the correct supplies and the high quality supplies required by the program we have collaborated with a company that prepares a kit with the needed supplies. The price of the overall kit is extremely reasonable based on the number and quality of the supplies contained in the kit. Visit the website below to view what's included in the equipment kit. The only equipment not found in the PT kit is a sphygmomanometer (blood pressure cuff) and stethoscope, which you are responsible for ordering on your own.

Stethoscope should have a double-sided chest-piece similar quality to 3M Littmann Classic III. Sphygmomanometer should have detachable gauge and adult size large similar in quality to Prestige Medical Aneroid Sphygmomanometer.

Each student must access the website below and order the kit before the Fall semester of year 1. The kits will be sent directly to the student at the address given during the ordering process.

During the first week of fall semester classes, students will need to demonstrate that they have obtained the kit. The purchase of this equipment kit is required by the Program.

****Note:** Purchase of kits from prior students is not allowed as the kit has changed over the past years. There are also some items in the kit which are disposable.

Technology Requirements

Laptop Computer:

You are required to have a laptop computer with a built-in webcam and updated operating systems.

Your computer and/or tablet must have capability for the following functions:

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- Wireless internet capability
- Word processing software (ie. Microsoft Word)
- Presentation software (ie. Microsoft Power Point)
- Video editing software (ie. Movie maker, I Movie)

Accessories:

- External charging devices/power supply
- Computer privacy filter which blacks out the view from side angles (outside 60 degrees) – similar to 14" Akamai Computer Privacy Screen (16:9) - Black Security Shield - Laptop Monitor Protector - UV and Blue Light Filter found on Amazon

Exam Soft Testing:

NSU DPT program uses ExamSoft for testing. Students may take the exams on a PC laptop, Mac laptop, or I Pad. Students will be asked to download the Examplify app during orientation. See minimum system requirements below for each device:

- **iPad Requirements** iPadOS 13 is supported on version 3.8 of Examplify for iPad
 - Hardware Requirements = iPad 5+, iPad Air, iPad Mini 2+, iPad Pro
 - Operating System = iOS 11, iOS 12, and iPadOS 13 (Only genuine versions of iOS are supported)
 - 500 MB of free space required to commence an exam
 - iPad must not be Jailbroken
 - Internet connection for Download, Registration, Exam Download and Upload.
 - In order to take an exam using an iPad, your institution must first enable iPad support.
- **PC Users**
 - Operating System: 32-bit and 64-bit Versions of Windows 10.
 - Alternate versions of Windows 10, such as Windows RT and Windows 10 S, are NOT supported at this time.
 - Only genuine, U.S.-English versions of Windows Operating Systems are supported.
 - ExamSoft does not support Tablet devices other than Surface Pro as detailed below
 - CPU Processor: 2.0 ghz Intel i3 processor or equivalent
 - RAM: 4GB or higher
 - Hard Drive: highest recommended for the operating system or 1GB of available space.
 - For onsite support, and in order to backup the answer files to USB, a working USB port is required (Newer devices may require an adaptor)
 - For technical troubleshooting, account passwords, including BitLocker keys, may be required.
 - Internet connection for Download, Registration, Exam Download and Upload.
 - Examplify cannot be run within virtualized environments or environments that require persistent network (local or otherwise) connections during secure exams. This includes, but is not limited to, VMWare, Parallels, Citrix workspace, Virtual Disks, Streamed images, etc.
 - Screen Resolution should be at least 1024x768 or higher.
 - Administrator level account permissions (Instructions)
 - If your institution does not allow the use of Microsoft Surface devices, Surface Pro and Surface Books are NOT permitted. Surface laptops that come with non-detachable keyboards are permitted. Non-Pro Surface devices are not supported for ANY institution.

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- **Mac Users**

- MacOS Catalina (version 10.15) is compatible with Exemplify v.2.0.6. Previous versions of Exemplify will not work with macOS Catalina
- Supported Operating Systems: OS X 10.13 (High Sierra), OS X 10.14 (Mojave), and macOS Catalina (10.15). Only genuine versions of Mac Operating Systems are supported.
- CPU: Intel processor
- RAM: 4GB or higher
- Hard Drive: 1GB or higher available space
- For onsite support, and in order to backup the answer files to USB, a working USB port is required (Newer devices may require an adaptor)
- For technical troubleshooting, account passwords, including device passwords, may be required.
- Server version of Mac OS X is not supported
- This software cannot be used on virtual operating systems such as Microsoft's Virtual Machine, Parallels, VMware, VMware Fusion or any other virtual environments.
- Internet connection for Download, Registration, Exam Download and Upload.
- Administrator level account permissions (Instructions)
- Exemplify cannot be run within virtualized environments or environments that require persistent network (local or otherwise) connections during secure exams. This includes, but is not limited to, VMWare, Parallels, Citrix workspace, Virtual Disks, Streamed images, etc.

Students have access to NSU sponsored downloads of certain software, once registered and fully enrolled.

Note: Smart watches can be used in labs and in some clinics, but are not allowed during testing.
