# NSU Identity

## Students

Your username is automatically generated and assigned to you when you become a new student. Prior to login to any of the NSU systems you need your username, and you are required to setup your account password. Passwords must have:

- A minimum of 8 characters in length.
- Passwords should contain a mix of uppercase letters, lowercase letters, numeric digits, and special characters (at least 3 of the 4 classes).

Student email addresses are in the format of username with the addition of @mysu.nova.edu domain. (e.g., username@mysu.nova.edu).

# Important Registration Information:

- **Student Enrollment Agreement (SEA)** must be completed to proceed with registration
  - For questions about the SEA go to <http://www.nova.edu/registrar/faqs.html> or call the Office of the University Registrar at (954) 262-7200
- **Payment** is due to the Bursar's Office as soon as you have registered for classes
  - Late fee of \$100 is assessed on accounts 30 days past due (30 days from beginning of the term)
  - A hold is also placed on a delinquent account that prevents future registrations, viewing grades, ordering a transcript or diploma.
  - Click on the Tuition and Fee Assessment link on the Registration Menu in Webstar to review your tuition and fees for this term
  - Log onto NSU's e-Bill, available at [www.nova.edu/nsuebill](http://www.nova.edu/nsuebill) to view your account and make payments online

# Important Registration Information:

- **Health Insurance Waiver** is available for completion 24 hours after you register
  - You must carry health insurance to be enrolled in the DPT program (can be your own or through NSU plan)
  - If you have your own health insurance, you must waive the NSU health insurance or you will be automatically charged (**no refunds if you do not waive**)

# Compliance Information:

- In order to attend NSU and participate in clinical education experiences, ongoing evidence of continued compliance is a requirement for all students. Compliance requirements include (at a minimum):
  - background checks (non-fingerprint and fingerprint)
  - drug screens
  - certificate of physical exam
  - Immunizations
  - proof you have health insurance
  - CPR certification
- In addition to above, students may be required to complete additional compliance requirements specific to each facility where they may be placed for their clinical experiences
- **IMPORTANT NOTE:** DPT students should not get physical exams or Tuberculosis testing until after orientation.

# Compliance Information:

- The DPT Program requirements for proof of immunizations is **more rigorous** than that of the College of Health Care Sciences. As a result, we require proof of vaccination **and** results of titers via lab blood draw. Detailed information about the immunization and other compliance requirements can be found at <https://healthsciences.nova.edu/pt/dpt/clinical-education/professional-dpt-program-compliance-checklist-2-24-20201.pdf> Please use the detailed description in Compliance Item Criteria section to understand exactly what you need to prove for each requirement.
- The immunization form found at [https://healthsciences.nova.edu/studentaffairs/orientation/forms/immunization\\_form.pdf](https://healthsciences.nova.edu/studentaffairs/orientation/forms/immunization_form.pdf) should be used to document the proof of immunizations **and** titers. Language on the form states that either proof of immunizations or titers should be documented, but you need to document **BOTH**

# Dress Code

## Orientation:

- Professional dress required for the first day of orientation (scrubs to be worn after the first day)
  - For men: trousers, dress shirt (necktie optional), socks, dress shoes
  - For women: dress/skirt (of appropriate length) or dress slacks, blouse and dress shoes
  - Students may not wear the following: shorts, cut-offs, mini-skirts (higher than mid-thigh), blue jeans, see-through clothing, tank tops, tube tops, or halter tops, sandals or sneakers, tee-shirts (as outer shirt), jogging or exercise clothing

## Program Dress Code:

- Scrubs: Pewter gray matching top and bottom scrubs with student first and last name embroidered on left chest (white block letters, 0.5 in height)
- Lab Clothes: Navy blue shorts (men's and women's styles available) with NSU PT logo and NSU PT logo t-shirt (with sleeves) – Lab clothes must be purchased in person from the NSU bookstore
- Clinic Attire: Navy blue NSU Logo PT polo shirt, comfortable fitting khaki pants, white coat, and supportive shoes (polo shirts ordered within first 2 semesters)
