

## Summer Residency

### 1. ATTENDANCE

Attendance at the Summer Residency is mandatory. It is suggested that you schedule your arrival and returning travel arrangements prior to the summer semester or as soon as possible after the dates for the Summer Residency classes are announced.

### 2. LODGING AND TRANSPORTATION

You will need a place to stay in the Fort Lauderdale/Davie area while you are here for the entire week of the Summer Residency. Please visit the NSU's Travel Office to find [hotels in the Fort Lauderdale area](#) which offer a discount to Nova Southeastern University's students. It is suggested that you have a car while you are here. Information on car rentals is also available on the NSU Travel Office site.

### 3. ARRIVAL, DEPARTURE

You will want to arrive in the Fort Lauderdale/Davie area by Monday night, the night before the Summer Residency classes begins. Classes for the Summer Residency will be held each day from 8:30 a.m. – 5:30pm EST.

### 4. PARKING

You must park in the designated area(s) for students that are closest to the building where the classes are located. You are to adhere to and follow all required parking rules and regulations while on main campus. It is suggested that you arrive on the main campus by 8:00 a.m. to find parking.
